GUIDELINES FOR THE SCRAPBOOK COMMITTEE

The Scrapbook Committee is usually composed of 3 – 5 Assembly members.

The Scrapbook Committee is responsible for finding JUDGES who will judge the scrapbooks.

Judges for the Scrapbook Competition cannot be a member of the Annie P. Rogers State Grand Assembly.

The Scrapbook Committee Chairperson is responsible for making sure the Assemblies receive the guidelines for the Scrapbook Competition.

The Scrapbook Committee Chairperson or her designee must find a private room large enough for the judges and the Committee.

The Committee will stay in the room with the Judges to ensure that the correct procedures are being followed.

Judges for the Scrapbook Competition will receive instructions on how to use the score sheets from the Chairperson of the Scrapbook Committee or her designee.

The Scrapbook Committee makes sure the JUDGES have what they need in order to judge the scrapbooks. (pens, pencils, scoring sheets, water, etc.)

The Scrapbook Committee must total the scores awarded to each scrapbook and determine the Winner, the 1st Runner Up Award, the 2nd Runner Up Award, and the 3rd Place Award. The Winner will receive a Plaque and the Runner Ups will receive certificates.

The Scrapbook Chairperson or her designee will present the Awards.

The Scrapbook Committee will return the scrapbooks to the Designated Viewing Table for pickup after the Awards are presented.

SCRAPBOOK COMPETITION GUIDELINES

The Assembly Scrapbook should represent the goals and objectives accomplished by the Assembly. The quality of the Scrapbook will be determined by the variety of activities performed by the Assembly.

1. The name of the Assembly and its number must be on the outside of the Scrapbook.
2. The Scrapbook Cover should be neat, creative, original and should incorporate the Order of the Golden Circle emblems and colors.
3. All Scrapbooks must contain AGENDAS for the meetings held by the Assembly during the year.
4. ALL PICTURES USED IN THE SCRAPBOOK MUST HAVE BEEN TAKEN DURING THE YEAR THE SCRAPBOOK IS SUBMITTED. No old photos are permitted.
5. All Scrapbooks must have a TABLE OF CONTENTS.
6. All Scrapbooks must have the Loyal Lady Ruler and Assembly Officers listed.
7. All Scrapbooks must include the LOCAL ASSEMBLY FOCUS and may include activities and projects such as Senior Citizens Programs, Youth Programs, Voter Activities, Charities, Community Involvement and local accomplishments of Assembly members.
8. All Scrapbooks must include an AREA FOCUS. This section may include AREA projects, AREA activities, attendance and accomplishments of the Assembly on the AREA level.
9. All Scrapbooks must include a STATE FOCUS. This section may include STATE projects, activities, the State Grand Loyal Lady Ruler's focus, members' accomplishments on the STATE level, and any other activities on the STATE level.
10. All Scrapbooks should be neat, organized and creative. Pages should not be falling out of the book and embellishments should not be falling off the cover.
11. All Scrapbooks should be placed in the designated room, on the designated display table by NOON on Friday.
12. Remember the quality of the scrapbook will not be determined by the number of pages or the size of the book. It will be determined by the variety of activities performed by the Assembly.

This section may include all or some of the following: Local activities, local projects, local Youth programs, Voter education/registration, charities, community involvement, and local accomplishments of members, etc.

This section may include Area projects, area activities, area attendance, and accomplishments of members on the area level.

This section may include recommended State projects and activities, State Grand Loyal Lady Ruler's special focus, accomplishments and other activities of members at the State Level.

IV. NEATNESS, CREATIVITY AND ORGANIZATION OF THE ASSEMBLY SCRAPBOOK (10)

Judges are to determine if the scrapbook is well put together, if pictures are clear and current, if pictures have captions, does the book have a table of contents, is there a theme, and if pictures and embellishments were used creatively?
